

Sir Elric enacted these verbally at the August event:

In combat, the field of battle will be defined. If the field is defined as limitless, then the combatants may be moved back to the center of the field when one is backed into a corner. If the field is defined as not limitless, if a combatant is backed up to the line, they must make a stand and will not be moved back to the center of the field. If the combatant steps over the line, they are dead. This would be equivalent to a combatant being backed to the edge of a cliff or body of water and falling off or in.

When a marshall speaks to a combatant, that is tantamount to a hold and all combat must cease. The rationale behind this is that one cannot heed the words of the marshal if combat continues. All blows struck after a hold is called are void.
